Louis XVI

- → king
- absolute monarch
- appointed by God
- supreme judge
- reigned and ruled
- declared war

First



Archbishop Brienne de Toulouse

- → clergy
- 1 per cent of the population
- bishops and priests
- received money from the people (fees, tithes)
- the high clergy owned much land (15 per cent)

Second



Duchess of Polignac

- → nobility
- -2-3 per cent of the population
- owned 40 per cent of the land
- held the top jobs in the army and in government
- did not pay much tax
- received dues from the

Georges Couthon, lawyer

- → peasants, workers, merchants doctors, lawyers, etc.
- 97 per cent of the population
- many peasants were poor
- paid most of the taxes
- had few political rights
- some well-educated people became very rich (even richer than some of the nobility)
