

History, 8th grade, Rights of Man

- I. Men are born and remain free and equal in rights.
- II. People have the right of liberty, of owning property, of security and of resistance to oppression.
 - VII. No person shall be accused, arrested, or imprisoned except in cases regulated by the law.
 - X. All citizens have the right to practise their religion.

XI. All citizens have the right to think, say and write what they like.

XIII. All citizens must pay taxes in proportion to their income.

III. No group or individual who is not elected by the people has the authority to make laws for the people.

XVI. A separation of powers is necessary for the proper functioning of society.
